I can also imagine that with the additional capacity, the kitchen space will increase. This will require more or larger exhaust fans. Already the exhaust fans can be heard throughout the night along with the smell s of t he kitchen. I am concerned with the overall impact to safety and quality of life that this project will cause.

Please do not approve the proposed expansion / renovation of the Oyster Bar restaurant and keep the character of our neighborhood intact.
