


How To Use the Interactive Map Web Page Martha's Vineyard Commission 3/24/05



To begin, click on the binocular button to view a list of ponds that you can zoom-in to. Once this other window opens, click on the arrow to view the list and then click on a pond name.



After you select a pond name from the list, the map will zoom to that pond and the data results sheet will appear in a separate window. The data result graphs file is an Adobe PDF file. The window it appears in can be resized. Also, the file can be printed on your local printer and/or saved to your hard drive.



Note, open windows, such as the one displaying the data results, may be minimized. However, the next time a pond name is selected from the zoom to list, the data results file for that pond will appear in the currently open data results window. Therefore, that window will need to be un-minimized in order to view the document.

Displaying Attributes

Another option is to do a quick zoom when the map is zoomed out to the full extent by moving the cursor over a pond on the map and if the cursor changes to the image of a hand, then click on that pond and the map will zoom to that pond.

Once zoomed in, if you move the cursor over a pond sampling station, road, or pond, the respective name of the feature will appear. If you click on a sampling station or a road, a brief table of information about that feature will appear in a new window. If you click on a pond, this will display the data results sheet.

You can zoom in further by clicking on the '+' sign or the '200'. To zoom out, click on the '-' sign or the '100'.



When the map is zoomed in as much as possible, the overview map button will appear. Click on this button to display the overview map. Once the overview map is displayed, click this button again to hide the overview map. Also, when zoomed in to the '200' level, you should notice the some black arrowheads around the border of the map. If you click on an arrowhead the map will shift in that direction. If an arrowhead is grey in color, then it is not possible to shift the map in that direction.



To zoom back to the original map view, click on the 1:1 button.

A map legend explaining the various symbols on the map can be viewed by clicking the legend button.



To print the map as it appears on your screen (possibly zoomed in on a pond or at the full map extent),



click on the printer icon button. A preview of what will be printed will be displayed. If you wish to print that image, click the 'print' button.
